

ABSTRACT

Management of Tofu and Tempeh Businesses to increase family income from an Islamic economic perspective (a case study of tofu and tempeh MSMEs in Girian Bawah village, Girian sub-district, Bitung City), Aminto Teguh Santos, Sharia Economic

This research focuses on the tofu and tempeh businesses in Girian Bawah Village, which comprised ten owners, all used as samples. This study aims to analyze the management of tofu and tempeh businesses in increasing family income, identify factors that support and hinder the business, and see the view of Islamic Economics on managing this business. This research was conducted for three months, from April 2024 to June 2024, by obtaining a recommendation letter from the Head of Girian Bawah Village, Girian Subdistrict, Bitung City. The data used are primary and secondary. Primary data was obtained through observation and interviews, while secondary data was derived from various related books. The analysis was descriptively qualitative. The results showed that business management does not apply management functions, where the business owners only focus on production and sales without evaluating. Despite capital and knowledge constraints, the business contributes positively to the owners. The business's income reached around IDR 5,000,000, above the 2024 standard of living of IDR 3,485,000. According to Islamic Economics, nothing contradicts Islam's teachings in managing these tofu and tempeh businesses.
